A part of comprehensive care is understanding our patients from head to toe- injury to recovery.

Your physician will ask you to complete a health status questionnaire before and after surgery. This questionnaire will be sent to you via email or text message from OBERD, or you may complete them online at BoneAndJointTN.org/quality-and-outcomes.

Pre-operative questionnaire MUST be completed prior to surgery

Why does my physician want this information?

- This questionnaire will help measure your level of ability and pain pre-operatively (before surgery) and post-operatively (after surgery), and will help your physician assess your health status for physical, mental, and social well-being.

What will my physician do with this information?

- Your physician will use this information to track your progress over time.

How do I complete the questionnaires?

- If you provided an email address or cell phone number to Bone and Joint Institute, you will receive an email or text from OBERD with a link to the questionnaire. You will receive a total of five questionnaires, both before and after surgery, at a frequency of one pre-operatively and four post-operatively – three months post, six months post, one year post, and two years post.
- If you did not receive a link to the questionnaires, go to BoneAndJointTN.org/quality-and-outcomes. Begin by entering your personal information. After you log in, you will be able to access the questionnaires. Click the "START" button next to the questionnaire to begin.

If you log in and do not see a questionnaire to complete, your physician is up-to-date on your current health status and there is no action required at this time.
